ORDINANCE NO. 191.2012

AN ORDINANCE ENACTING AND IMPLEMENTING AN ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICE FEE AND VEHICLE USE FEE RELATED TO SHERIFF DEPARTMENT ASSIGNMENTS FOR SHERIFF'S DEPUTIES PERFORMING PRIVATE JOBS IN OFF-DUTY HOURS AND AUTHORIZING THE CHARGE, COLLECTION, AND DISPOSITION OF THE STATED FEE.

Pursuant to the authority granted by the Constitution and the General Assembly of the State of South Carolina, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL FOR KERSHAW COUNTY:

SECTION I Kershaw County hereby establishes a \$25.00 administrative service fee and vehicle use fee per vehicle for Sheriff Department assignments for Sheriff's Deputies performing private jobs in off-duty hours.

SECTION II Kershaw County hereby enacts and implements an Administrative Service Fee and Vehicle Use Fee of \$25.00 per vehicle, to be collected by the Sheriff on behalf of Kershaw County from parties who request Sheriff's Deputies performing private jobs in off-duty hours, and which are authorized by the Sheriff pursuant to the South Carolina Code of Laws Section 23-24-10 et seq. Funds collected by the Sheriff that are derived from the \$25.00 administrative fee and per vehicle use fee for Sheriff's Deputies performing private jobs in off-duty hours shall be deposited directly into a Sheriff Administrative Fee revenue account in the General Fund. The purpose of collecting this revenue will be to offset the cost of the use of Kershaw County Sheriff's Department vehicles including fuel and lubricants, and administration of Sheriff's Deputies performing private jobs in off-duty hours.

SECTION III Severability. If any section, subsection, or clause of this ordinance shall be deemed to be unconstitutional or otherwise invalid, the validity of the remaining sections, subsections, and clauses shall not be affected thereby.

SECTION IV Conflicting Ordinances Repealed. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION V Effective Date. This ordinance shall be enforced from and after January 10, 2012.
